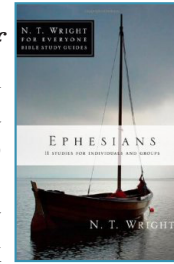

Wednesday Night Adult Studies

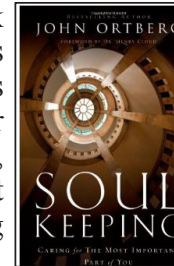

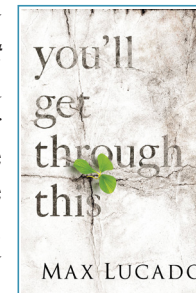
Sunday Night Adult Study

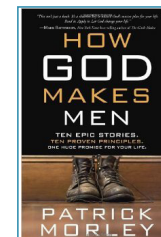
Women's Bible Study
