#### **Deacon Nominations**

Nomination forms will be available in the church office, during the month of September.

These nominations will be for a three (3) year term of office to begin in January 2023. To qualify for this office, a person must:

- 1. Be a member of this church for at least three (3) consecutive years
- 2. Must be at least twenty-five (25) years of age
- 3. Cannot be a member of the church staff, a salaried employee, or a household member of church ministerial staff. In addition, two (2) household members may not serve simultaneously on the Board of Deacons.

A list of nominees will be published in the church publications during the first week of October, with the election of Deacons to be held during worship on October 16, 2022.
