As you may recall, the first Thanksgiving was celebrated jointly between 53 Pilgrim survivors and 90 Native Americans in October 1621 following the Pilgrims' first harvest in their new colony. Their first winter was brutal, claiming over half of the Pilgrims who made the journey to establish a new colony. With the help of the Native Americans, the survivors learned to plant, hunt, and prepare for the brutal winters ahead. To celebrate God's blessings, they held a three-day festival, enjoying the fruits of their labor, giving thanks to God.

Gratitude is important. It is not that God needs us to be grateful. Rather, we need to be grateful. It is good for both our mental and spiritual health. Gratitude helps us to focus on what we have, not what we do not have. It helps us to see the good, even in the midst of the bad. Gratitude reminds us of the source of our blessings. All good things come from God. And, gratitude for what we have helps us to have compassion for those who do not have what we have.
