#### A Note from the Pastor

The book of Acts recalls an important story about fellowship. An angel visited a centurion named Cornelius, sharing a message and mission from the Lord. Cornelius was generous and gave many resources to the poor. He was a God-fearer, meaning that he knew Israel's God, but had not taken the steps to "officially" convert. The angel told Cornelius to send for Peter, who was staying in Joppa, a coastal town, at the time. Cornelius complied and sent two men to fetch Peter and to bring him to his home.

As the men were on the way, Peter was praying on the rooftop. He became hungry and had a vision. In the vision, the Lord revealed several animals that faithful Jews would have considered "unclean." Peter was told to eat. At first, he balked, but the Lord declared them clean.

Why is this important? Declaring all foods clean was not about health. It was not about convenience. It was about declaring the people who ate those foods clean. The message of Jesus was not for Israel only. Rather, it was for the whole world. If the disciples were to leave the familiarity of Israel, and if they were to share Jesus with those outside their faith, then they would have to meet people where they would be open and receptive. Often, that would be at the table.

Sharing a meal is a wonderful opportunity to strengthen existing relationships. More than that, it is a wonderful opportunity to build relationships. That's why we are placing an emphasis on fellowship opportunities at First Baptist. When we resumed Wednesday Night Meals in November, it was a joy to see families eating together. But it was also a joy to see people together that maybe we would not normally see together.

I would love to invite you to take advantage of Wednesday Night Meals beginning Wednesday, January 17! We will continue offering them at the price of \$8 per adult, \$5 per child (ages  $3-5^{th}$  Grade), and children ages 2 and under may eat free! You may sign up and pay through Realm or you may sign up on the Pew Pads or by calling the church office! Join us for a good meal! Strengthen the relationships you have! Build new ones as well! Eating together is not only nourishing for the body, but for the soul as well!
